Description Caribbean Premium

DAY 1 - LE MARIN / BEQUIA (Navigation time: 13H)

Your catamaran awaits you at the Marina du Marin, boarding from 6 p.m. The small resort town of Le Marin is located on the south end of the island overlooking the mangrove-lined waterfront. It's known as the yachting capital of Martinique with its deep bay, excellent infrastructure, and well-protected harbor. As the first marina of the Lesser Antilles, Marina du Marin is the ideal location for cruises departing for the Grenadines.

You'll be welcomed on board by your crew so you can get settled in your cabin. Later, you'll depart for a night of navigation along the coasts of St. Lucia and St. Vincent toward the island of Bequia.

DAY 2 – BEQUIA

Arrive early in the morning in Bequia (pronounced "BECK-way"), the first of the islands of the Grenadines archipelago. Enjoy some leisure time at anchor in the harbor of Admiralty Bay and take in some swimming, snorkeling or water sports while your skipper takes care of the formalities ashore. The capital Port Elisabeth is a lively little town whose bars proudly display the portrait of the Queen of England, a mark of attachment to the former colonial power. Have lunch on board followed by a visit to the island in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight on board.

Optional: Bequia: tour of the village by taxi, with a visit to the "turtle farm", a refuge where injured turtles are taken in before being released back into their natural environment, as well as a real nursery for "baby turtles" (Approximately 2h30).

DAY 3 – BEQUIA / MUSTIQUE / MAYREAU (Navigation time: 2H + 3H)

Depart from Bequia at 5:30 a.m. to arrive in Mustique in time for breakfast. Discover the island of the "jetsetters", a favorite among the rich and famous celebrities of Hollywood! The island's luxury hotels, intimate villas, select bars and gourmet restaurants create a surprisingly refined universe in the heart of the tropical Grenadines. While at anchor, take the opportunity to enjoy some swimming and water sports: snorkeling, kayaking, stand-up paddle.

In the early afternoon you'll sail to Mayreau. This island is the least populated of the archipelago with about 300 inhabitants. The only village on Mayreau is accessible in less than an hour walk from the beach of Saline Bay. It's worth the detour for its colorful wooden huts, and unique bars and restaurants. A small stone church erected at the top of a hill offers superb panoramic views of the neighboring islands! Dinner and overnight on board.

DAY 4 –MAYREAU/TOBAGO CAYS (Navigation time: 0.5H)

Enjoy the beauty of Mayreau all morning. After lunch, depart for the famous Tobago Cays with islets, lagoons and reefs crowning the most beautiful lagoon of the Grenadines! You are truly in the heart of a tropical paradise. Enjoy a relaxing day, where you can immerse yourself in the underwater enchantment of the shallow coral reefs with swimming and snorkeling to your heart's content. Take in the Caribbean vibes and sunshine on this famed fine sandy beach.

Venture on the foot paths of the desert islands to discover cacti, frangipani and endemic shrubs.

Optional: enjoy a casual BBQ on the beach with lobster or conch, and fish dinner depending on the season.

DAY 5 – TOBAGO CAYS / LITTLE ST VINCENT (Navigation time: 1H)

In the middle of the afternoon, after a last swim with the turtles, a short sail will bring you to the island of Petit St-Vincent (hotel island) with its stunning turquoise waters. In the early evening, go ashore to experience a local bar ashore. Dinner and overnight on board.

DAY 6 – LITTLE ST VINCENT / MOPION / UNION Chatham Bay (Navigation time: 1H)

Next on your journey is the tiny and instagram-worthy sand bar called Mopian Island, surrounded by lovely reefs and recognized for its single thatch roof umbrella. Enjoy the solitude with a stroll on the beach and go for a swim in this unique and well-known spot. In the afternoon, a short sail will deliver you to one of the most beautiful bays of the Grenadines, Chatham Bay. After lunch, swim with the turtles, snorkel, paddle, kayak or walk on the beach.

DAY 7 – CHATHAM BAY / PALM ISLAND / UNION (Navigation time: 1H)

Awake to a breakfast aboard in Chatham Bay before heading to Palm Island for lunch with a view. In the afternoon, depart for a short sail to Union Island, the “capital” of the Grenadines. The small island is the southernmost in the Grenadines and has an airport, hotels, restaurants, fruit and vegetable market, supermarkets, and Internet cafés. Go ashore and visit the picturesque village nearby after dinner if there’s time and discover some of the local bars.

DAY 8 - UNION / BEQUIA / CUMBERLAND (ST VINCENT) (Navigation time: 4.5H + 2.5H)

Depart after breakfast and sail back to Bequia. Lunch on board. In the early afternoon, depart for Cumberland Bay downwind of Saint Vincent.

DAY 9 - SAINT VINCENT/ SAINT LUCIA (Navigation time: 5.5H)

Breakfast on board.

Optional – choose to explore the island ashore: ride inland by minibus with driver and guide, discovering local villages, driving the scenic Caribbean coast, and swimming under a beautiful waterfall after a crossing on a suspension bridge.

After lunch, set sail for the 2 towering peaks of the famed Pitons, emblems of Saint Lucia. Dinner and overnight on board.

DAY 10 - SAINTE LUCIA / SAINTE ANNE (MARTINIQUE) (Navigation time: 5.5H)

Breakfast on board.

Optional: Explore St. Lucia by taxi with guide: See the village of La Soufrière at the foot of the Pitons, the most important of the 17th century, discover the botanical garden, swim in the springs and sulphurous baths, and see the crater of the Soufrière volcano still active with its boiling water geysers.

Lunch while sailing downwind of the island, towards Sainte Anne in Martinique. Dinner and overnight on board.

DAY 11 - SAINTE ANNE / MARIN (Navigation time: 0.5H)

Breakfast on board, followed by a short sail to disembark at Port du Marin at 10 a.m.

NB: Itinerary subject to change without notice, depending on weather conditions and / or technical reasons. Sailing times given above are based on an average cruising speed of 7 knots. They may vary depending on sea state, wind speed and weather conditions.

IMPORTANT

A passport valid for six months after the departure date is mandatory.

DREAM CARIBBEAN EXCURSION PACKAGE: *to be booked and paid for before departure (170 euros/per person)*

Day 2: Bequia: tour of the village by taxi, with a visit to the "turtle farm", a refuge where injured turtles are taken in before being released back into their natural environment, as well as a real nursery for "baby turtles" (Approximately 2h30)

Day 4: Tobago Cays: BBQ evening on the beach: aperitif, lobster dinner (depending on the season) or conch/fish.

Day 9: St Vincent: ride inland by minibus with driver-guide: typical village, panoramic road along the Caribbean coast, swimming under a waterfall of fresh water after crossing a suspension bridge (appropriate shoes recommended) (about 2h30)

Day 10: St Lucia: Visit the island by taxi and guide: visit the village of La Soufrière which was the most important village in the 17th century, the Botanical Garden, discover the Soufrière crater, a still active volcano with a bubbling mud lake and its sulphurous springs where you can swim (about 3h30).

Included:

- Accommodation in air-conditioned double cabin with private bathroom (A/C in service from 8:00am to 10:00pm)
- Full board (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- 1 local cocktail every evening per guest (made from rum, prosecco, etc...depending on destination // not personalized), drinks (table wine) during meals, fruit juices, sodas
- Service of the crew: two persons (captain, steward/cook)
- Two sets of linen, towels and beach towels per person/week
- Consumables for the yacht (diesel, fuel and water)
- Insurance for the yacht and the passengers
- Water sports on board: snorkeling equipment, fishing gear, 2 paddles & 1 kayak tandem (in case of availability issue the kayak tandem may be replaced by a single kayak)

Not included:

- Airfares
- Transfers airport – base – airport (optional)
- Destination fee (mandatory) : payable in advance
- Excursions package (optional): 170 Euro per person
- Personal travel insurance
- Alcoholic drinks apart of any mentioned above is included
- Charge for late passport info: 150 € per cabin, payable at the base (it does not concern last-minute bookings & done to ensure other passengers are not impacted because 1 client did not give info resulting in cabin cruise start delay).
